TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code § 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. § 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Beaver County as it pertains to the highway located in Beaver County known as DRY CREEK LOOP; County Road Number: B-180; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD010070. Total road length is 1.36 miles more or less.

The reasons for this acknowledgment are as follows (indicated by an “X” in one or more blocks and any supplemental comment):

- The road was laid out or erected for public use over public lands not reserved for public uses prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses;
- By reason of its continuous use as a public highway over public lands not reserved for public uses for a period of at least ten years prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses;
- Other (explain).

A printed copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or obtained at the office of the Utah State Archives.

An electronic copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices referenced in the Attachments, may be viewed and/or downloaded as read-only PDF (Portable

Document Format) files via the Internet at <http://recorded2477roads.utah.gov>.

The owner of the servient estate in the land underlying the road-segments subject to this Acknowledgment and Notice is believed to be the United States of America through one or more of its agencies. Any of such agencies or any other person with a servient ownership claim or a competing dominant estate right-of-way ownership claim, may file a petition in the State District Court for Salt Lake County for a decision regarding the correctness of this Acknowledgment. A claimant shall file a petition within sixty (60) days after receipt of this Notice.

In Witness Whereof, I, Lynn H. Stevens, the official designee of the Governor of the State of Utah, in conformity to the laws of the State (Utah Code Sections 72-5-308 through 310), have caused this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment to be made and the Seal of the State of Utah to be hereunto affixed.

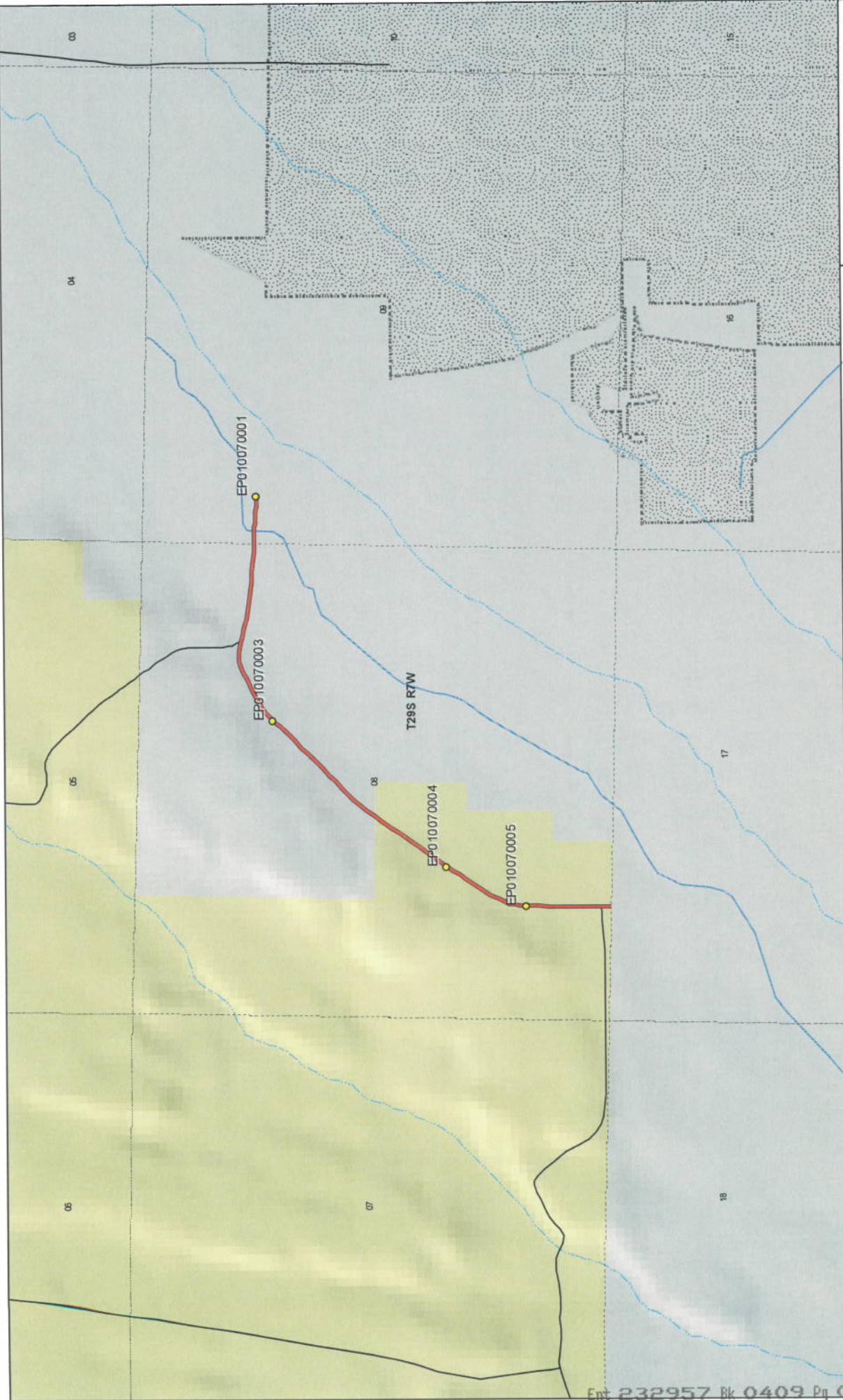
