TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code § 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. § 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Beaver County as it pertains to the highway located in Beaver County known as HOT SPRING ROAD; County Road Number: B-40; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD010125. Total road length is 5.99 miles more or less.

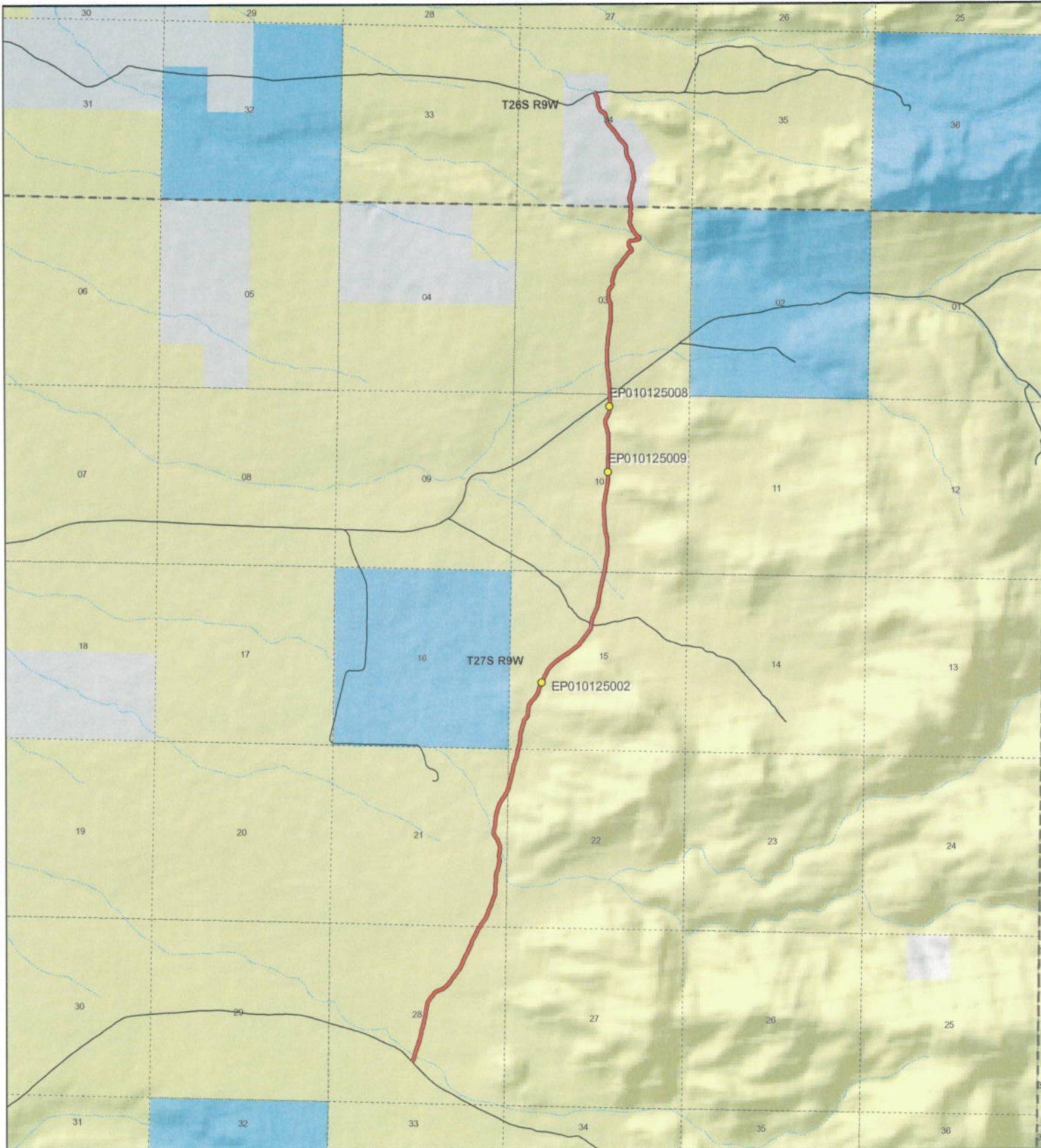
The reasons for this acknowledgment are as follows (indicated by an “X” in one or more blocks and any supplemental comment):

- The road was laid out or erected for public use over public lands not reserved for public uses prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses;
- By reason of its continuous use as a public highway over public lands not reserved for public uses for a period of at least ten years prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses;

Beginning at a point on the road centerline located at 38 degrees 25 minutes 047.1 seconds North Latitude and -112 degrees 52 minutes 14.95 seconds West Longitude, which can be converted to mapping accuracy State Plane Utah South Zone NAD 83 feet coordinates of X = 1,247,721.1 feet and Y = 10,487,374.7 feet based on the US Survey Foot conversion.

Ending at a point on the road centerline located at 38 degrees 30 minutes 32.37 seconds North Latitude and -112 degrees 51 minutes 12.41 seconds West Longitude, which can be converted to mapping accuracy State Plane Utah South Zone NAD 83 feet coordinates of X = 1,253,114.7 feet and Y = 10,516,158.1 feet based on the US Survey Foot conversion.
