AFFIDAVIT OF LEON FILLINGIM

LEON FILLINGIM, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based on my personal knowledge.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Duchesne County known to me as the Pipeline Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. Attached is a Duchesne County map showing the Pipeline Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map. I am informed that Duchesne County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

3. I have observed the Pipeline Road (County Road # 238) in Duchesne County since prior to 1964. The Pipeline Road runs from the Wells Draw Road to the Green River Access.

4. I am familiar with the indicated road for the same reasons identified in paragraph #3.

5. It is the reputation in the community that this road was used by the general public since at least 1938, and has been continuously since that time.

6. The road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as prior to 1964 and continuing through 1976 and beyond.

7. Since at least as early as 1963 and continuing to the present the road has been used for ranching, traveling in and through the area, recreation, accessing state school and institutional trust lands, hunting and other sportsmen access, state and local government access, oil and mineral exploration and drilling and contractors.

8. Travelers on the road from at least as early as prior to 1964 and continuing thereafter included those who went by foot, horseback, car, motorcycle, recreational vehicle and truck.

9. As grader operator I first maintained this road with road graders at least as early as twice a year from 1964 to 1988.

10. When I first used and observed the road it ran the same route as it does now, and the road was well established as prior to 1964..

11. At no time during my tenure as Road Supervisor did the County undertake any procedure to abandon or vacate it's right-of-way on the road.

12. This road has been included in the state highway system or infrastructure and has been designated as a Class B highway over which the County has been given jurisdiction by the state legislature for construction, operations and maintenance. The road has been on the official county road system since 1976. The road has been maintained since prior to 1964 by the County as a public highway, freely open for all to come and go as they please. This road had to be opened at least 1 time a day during the winter for pumpers. In 1965 the oil company built the pipeline along this road. We did most of the maintenance on this road both before and after the

pipeline was built. The pumpers had to keep natural gas flowing in this pipeline.




