of Acceptance of R.S. 2477
Right-of-Way Grant**

THE STATE OF UTAH

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:

Know ye, This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code Sections 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive, that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. Section 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision Duchesne County as it pertains to the highway located in Duchesne County known as Fork Road; County Road Number: 706; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD070067. Total road length is 0.54 miles more or less.

The reason for this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment includes, but is not limited to, the fact that the road was constructed, mechanically, or by continuous use as a public highway for a period of at least ten years, over public lands not reserved for public uses, prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses.

This Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment applies only to the segments of the road that traverse land owned by the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, and does not apply to segments of the road that traverse land owned by any other person or entity. The State of Utah and its political subdivisions reserve the right to make further acknowledgments and notices of acknowledgment with regard to road segments that traverse land owned by other entities, including the United States of America, through one or more of its agencies.

A printed copy of a map showing the location of the road in said county is appended hereto as “Attachment 1,” a printed copy of representative photos of the road is appended hereto as “Attachment 2,” a printed copy of a description of the beginning and ending points of the entire road together with a list of Townships, Ranges and Sections that may be traversed by the road in said county is appended hereto as “Attachment 3,” and a printed copy of the Road Centerline Description Cover Page(s) is appended hereto as “Attachment 4.” The Appendices listed in “Attachment 4” that contain the actual road centerline descriptions are incorporated herein by reference. Affidavits provided by individuals familiar with the road are appended hereto as “Attachment 5.”

A printed copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or obtained at the office of the Utah State Archives.

An electronic copy of this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment, together with its Attachments and Appendices, may be viewed and/or downloaded as read-only PDF (Portable Document Format) files via the

Internet at <http://recorded2477roads.utah.gov>.

The owner of the servient estate in the land underlying the road-segments subject to this Acknowledgment and Notice is believed to be the United States of America through one or more of its agencies. Any of such agencies or any other person with a servient ownership claim or a competing dominant estate right-of-way ownership claim, may file a petition in the State District Court for Salt Lake County for a decision regarding the correctness of this Acknowledgment. A claimant shall file a petition within sixty (60) days after receipt of this Notice.

In Witness Whereof, I, John Harja, the official designee of the Governor of the State of Utah, in conformity to the laws of the State (Utah Code Sections 72-5-308 through 310 inclusive), have caused this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment to be made.

I, JAMES L. BROWN, testify and declare under oath as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth in this affidavit. My testimony is based upon my personal knowledge and experience. I was born on May 10, 1942, in Evanston, Wyoming. I have lived in Duchesne County since 1970. I did seasonal work for the BLM and Forest Service in Duchesne, County from 1965 to 1970.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with Fork Road, Duchesne County Road 708, and the land it traverses.

3. I took the following steps to verify that the Road I refer to in this affidavit and Fork Road (the “ Road”) are the same road:

a. I examined a large Duchesne County map depicting the Road in relation to other roads, intersections and landmarks. I observed the Road on the large map verifying that it is accurately depicted on the map and it is the road I refer to herein.

b. I examined the map attached to this affidavit depicting the Road and surrounding area and verified that the Road is accurately depicted on the map and is the road I refer to herein.

c. I examined ground photos depicting the road and surrounding area and verified that the Road is accurately depicted in the photos and is the Road I refer to herein.

4. I have personally traveled the Road from 1965 through 1976 and continuing until 2000, (“the Time Period of My Experience”). It is the reputation in the community that the Road has been traveled as early as the early 1900s. I rode the road on horseback looking for cattle in the 1960s

and 1970s.

5. When I last traveled and observed the Road in 2000, it followed the same route as in the 1965, when I first traveled and observed it.

6. During the Time Period of My Experience the Road has been traveled daily when wood was hauled and weekly, weather permitting, during other periods. Based upon my observation during the Time Period of My Experience, the Road was continuously used as a public thoroughfare by members of the public for public purposes whenever it was necessary and convenient for them to do so and I have never known the use of the road to have been interrupted by any means.

7. During the Time Period of My Experience I have personally traveled the Road by horseback and pick up truck and have observed others traveling the road in pick up trucks, trailers and ATVs.

8. During the Time Period of My Experience I have personally used the Road for livestock operations, hunting and have observed others use the Road for the same purposes, plus wood gathering.

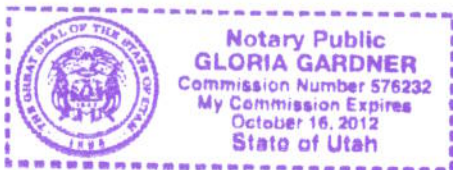
9. I have observed evidence of hand and small equipment maintenance on portions of the road.

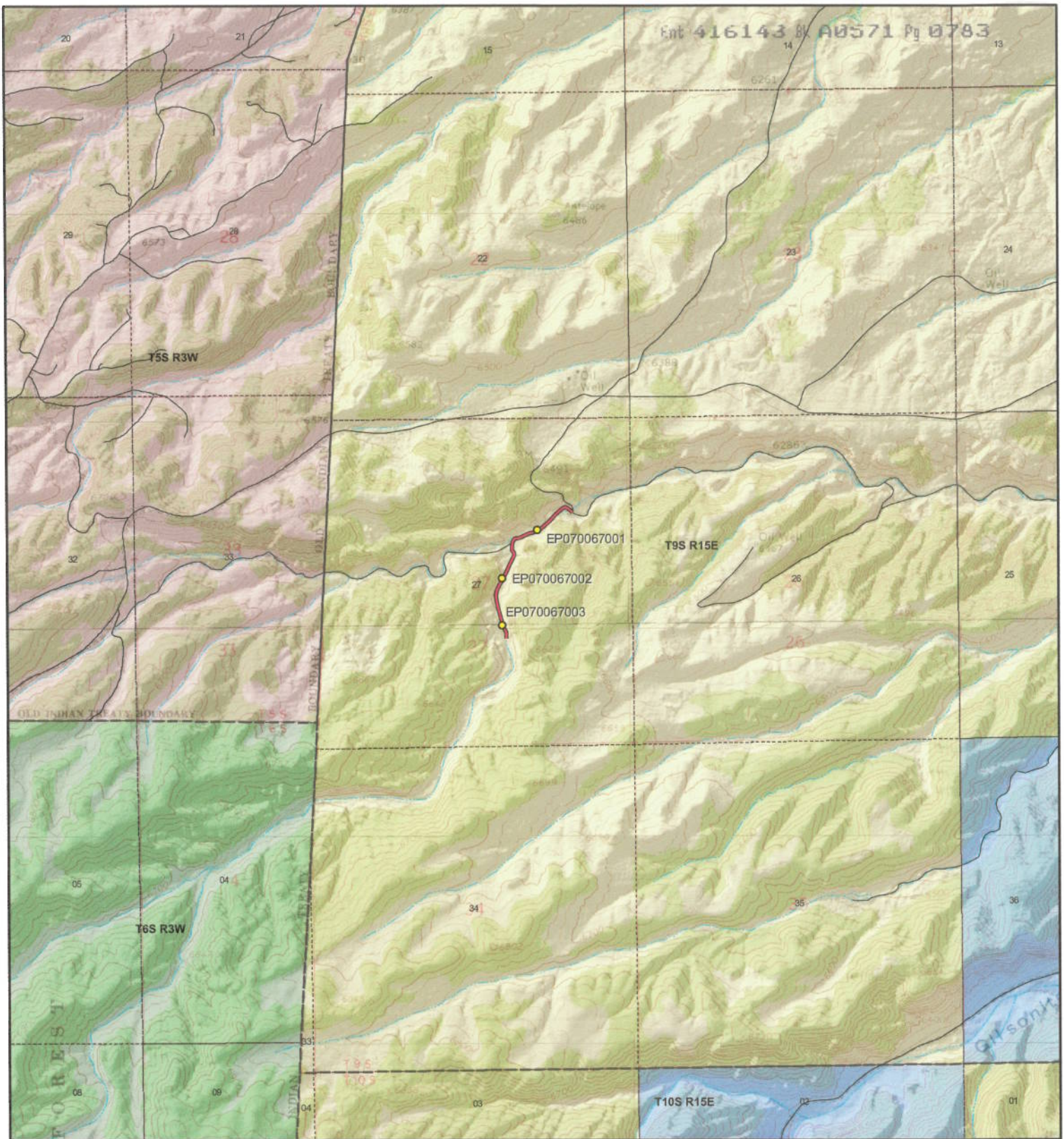

I, LEON FILLINGIM, testify and declare under oath as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth in this affidavit. My testimony is based upon my personal knowledge and experience. I was born on May 21, 1938, in Vernal, Uintah County, Utah. I have lived in Duchesne County all of my life. I supervised the maintenance of Roads in Duchesne county as Superintendent of the County Road Department from 1988 to 1996. I was also a road grader operator from 1964 to 1988. During the time of my employment with Duchesne county I used heavy machinery to construct and grade roads in the summer and to open snowbound roads in the winter.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with Fork Road, Duchesne County Road 706 and the land it traverses.

3. I took the following steps to verify that the road I refer to in this affidavit as Fork Road and Duchesne County Road 708 (the “ Road”) are the same road:

a. I examined a large Duchesne County map depicting the Road in relation to other roads, intersections and landmarks. I observed the Road on the large map verifying that it is accurately depicted on the map and it is the road I refer to herein.

b. I examined the map attached to this affidavit depicting the Road and surrounding area and verified that the Road is accurately depicted on the map and is the road I refer to herein.

c. I viewed ground photography and verified that it accurately depicts the Road I refer to in this affidavit.

4. I personally traveled the Road from the early 1940s through 1976 and continuing until 2008, (“the Time Period of My Experience”). It is the reputation in the community that the Road was traveled as early as the early 1900s, prior to my earliest recollection.

5. When I last traveled and observed the Road in 2008, it followed the same route as in the early 1940s, when I first traveled and observed it.

6. During the Time Period of My Experience the Road has been traveled weekly, weather permitting. Based upon my observation during the Time Period of My Experience, the road was continuously used as a public thoroughfare by members of the public for public purposes whenever it was necessary and convenient for them to do so and I have never known the use of the Road to have been interrupted by any means.

7. During the Time Period of My Experience I have personally traveled the Road by various means, including pickup truck and I have observed others from the general public use the road by the same means and ATVs and livestock vehicles.

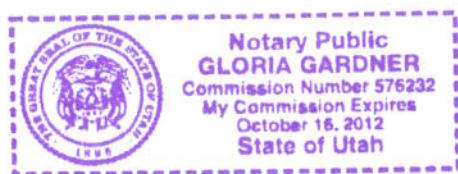

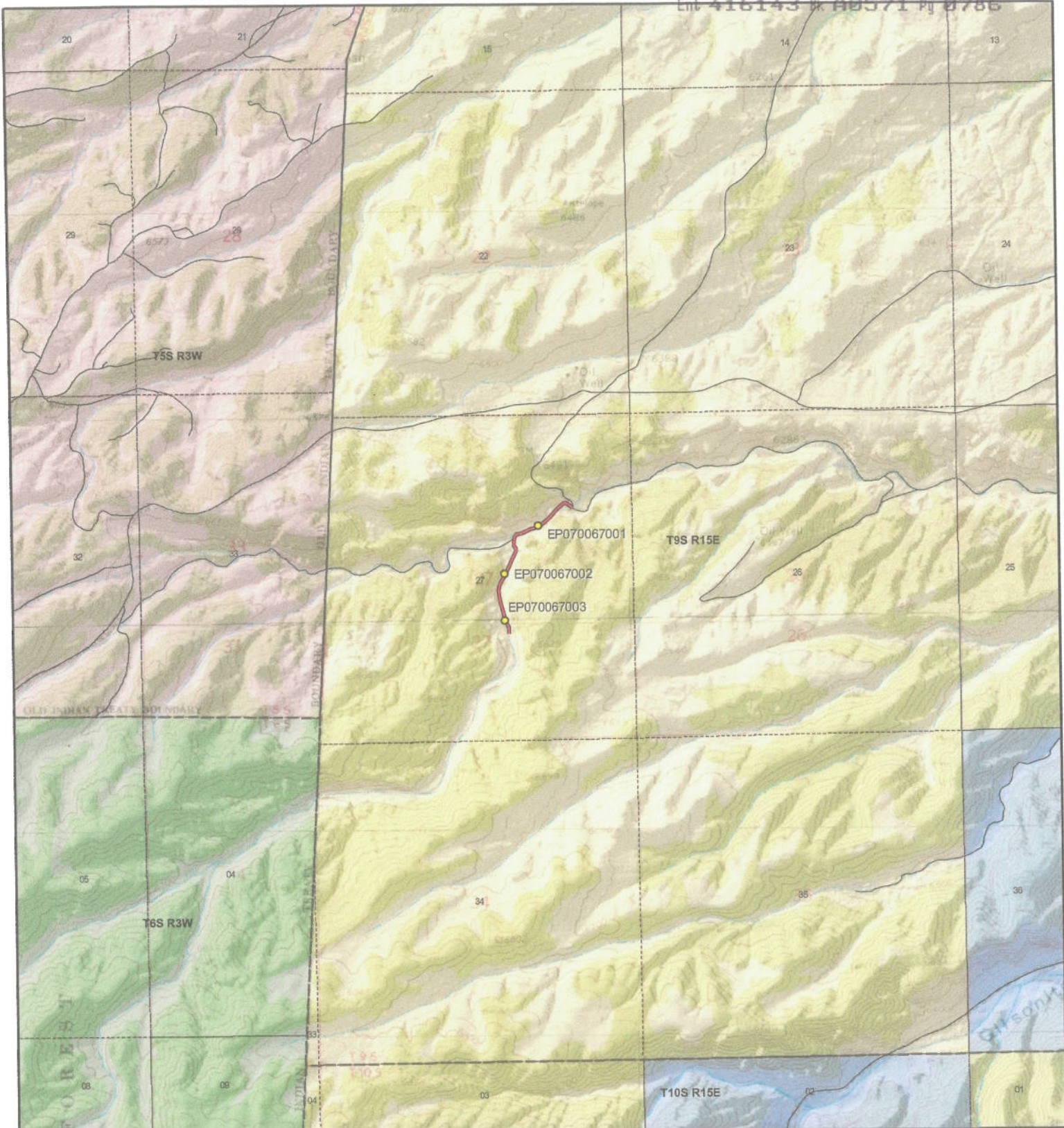

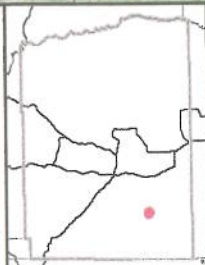

The following description is based upon the geographic coordinate system using the NAD83 Datum. The source is GPS mapping grade data as indicated in the metadata and/or the transportation data model of the State of Utah Geographic Information Database (SGID).

The road-segment itself is the monument that is identified by its physical presence on the land. The location of said physical presence is closely approximated by mapping grade Global Positioning System (GPS) data. Said data are checked against the corresponding gray-scale 1-meter Digital Orthophoto Quadrangles published by the United States Geological Survey (USGS) to verify a reasonable degree of accuracy. In circumstances where accurate satellite signal acquisition is not possible, such as deep, narrow canyons or under a canopy of dense foliage, or where very sharp curves in the road make accuracy questionable, such portions of the road were digitized from the corresponding gray-scale 1-meter Digital Orthophoto Quadrangles published by the United States Geological Survey (USGS).
