

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in Iron County, Utah. I have lived in Iron County since 1942. I was an employee of the Iron County Road Department from 1963 to 1987 and served as the Road Foreman from 1974 to 1987. I participated in the maintenance of the above referenced road during that time.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Iron County known as Lost Springs Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1960s, it followed the same route as in 1987 when I last observed it. Attached is a Iron County map showing Lost Springs Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1960s and continuing through 1976 to 1987. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by means of pickup trucks, road maintenance vehicles and trucks. Throughout this time period, the road has been used weekly, weather permitting.



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


I am an employee of the Iron County Road Department and have been since August of 1974. I have been the Road Foreman since July of 1987. I have participated in the maintenance of the above referenced road throughout the time period of my employment.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in Iron County known as Lost Springs Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1970s, it followed the same route as in 2006 when I last observed it. Attached is a Iron County map showing Lost Springs Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County also identifies this road according to the road number listed above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1970s and continuing through 1976 to the present. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by means of pickup trucks and road maintenance vehicles. Throughout this time period, the road has been used weekly, weather permitting.



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

