**TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME, Greeting:**

**Know ye,** This is an Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment made under Utah Code Sections 72-5-309 through 310 inclusive, that the grant of the United States of America of “the right of way for the construction of highways over public lands, not reserved for public uses” under United States Revised Statutes 2477 (43 U.S.C. Section 932 (repealed October 21, 1976, with proviso recognizing the validity of rights-of-way already established)) was accepted for and on behalf of the State of Utah and its political subdivision San Juan County as it pertains to the highway located in San Juan County known as LONG CANYON POINT ROAD; County Road Number: B190; State Geographic Information Database (SGID) Road Identification Number: RD190144. Total road length is 6.24 miles more or less.

The reason for this Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment includes, but is not limited to, the fact that the road was constructed, mechanically, or by continuous use as a public highway for a period of at least ten years, over public lands not reserved for public uses, prior to the earlier of (a) the October 21, 1976 repeal of R.S. 2477 or (b) the date the servient estate was reserved for public uses.


This Acknowledgment and Notice of Acknowledgment applies only to the segments of the road that traverse land owned by the Bureau of Land Management, United States Department of the Interior, and does not apply to segments of the road that traverse land owned by any other person or entity. The State of Utah and its political subdivisions reserve the right to make further acknowledgments and notices of acknowledgment with regard to road segments that traverse land owned by other entities, including the United States of America, through one or more of its agencies.



Lynn L. Adams, being first duly sworn, deposes and states as follows:

1. I am an adult competent to testify about the matters set forth below based upon my personal knowledge. I currently reside in San Juan County, Utah. I have lived in San Juan County for 82 years. I worked for the San Juan County Roads Department from 1961 to 1987.

2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in San Juan County known as Long Canyon Point Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the early 1950s, it followed the same route as in 2004, when I last observed it. Attached is a San Juan County map showing Long Canyon Point Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County identifies this road according to the road number described above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the early 1950s and continuing through 1976 to 2004. Throughout this time period I have observed travel on the road by various means, including: car, truck, pickup, motorcycle, and ATV. Throughout this time period, the road has

been used daily, weather permitting, for more than 10 continuous years prior to 1976 and was used daily, weather permitting, in 2004.


5. Throughout the time period from the early 1950s to 2004, I have used the road myself for the following uses: maintenance services and livestock operations.







2. I have traveled and am familiar with a road in San Juan County known as Long Canyon Point Road. I am also familiar with the land the road traverses. When I first used and observed the road in the mid 1950s, it followed the same route as in 2006, when I last observed it. Attached is a San Juan County map showing Long Canyon Point Road. To the best of my knowledge and based upon my use of and familiarity with this road and the land it traverses, the location and route of the road are correctly illustrated on the attached map.

3. I am informed that the County identifies this road according to the road number described above.

4. I have observed that the road has been open to the public for all to use, to come and go as they pleased, since at least as early as the mid 1950s and continuing through 1976 to 2006. Throughout this time period, the road has been used daily for more than 10 continuous years prior to 1976, and is presently used daily.


